







Programming of your new remote with an already programmed remote control:

Remove the protection cap from the battery.

- 1. Press simultaneously the two top buttons on the new remote. Release the buttons.
- 2. Press again at the same time on the top two buttons on the new remote. The LED of the new remote control flashes three times. Release the buttons.
- 3. Press the button you want to use. The LED of the new remote will flash once. Release the button.
- 4. Place the new remote and the original remote "back to back"
- 5. Press the button on the old remote, which you want to copy.
- 6. The LED on the new remote begins to flash rapidly, after a few seconds it will flash 3 times slowly.
- 7. Let go of the button on the original programmed remote.
- 8. Wait a few seconds. The new remote will flash once.
- 9. Your new remote control is now programmed.

Note: You can program all other buttons on your remote with the same procedure.

Regulation of the transmission power of the new remote:

Note: If after programming the new remote it works only on a very short range (a few centimeters away from the motor or 1-2 m), replace the battery first.

If the problem persists, you can adjust the transmit power. Follow the instructions:

- 1. Open the new remote control completely.
- 2. On the board of the new remote is at the top right corner a small screw. (see Fig 1).
- 3. Go next to your engine, turn the screw and test the transmitter again.
- 4. At a certain point, the transmitter should operate normally.
